222-22e: Fort Resolution screening- not sure why this keeps being put on; screening completed for waste disposal a long time ago, and we see no need to screen drawings etc

222-22f: Globaltex -screening- completed and sent over to the Board for the last meeting with licence

222-22k: J. Rocher marina: no change that I'm aware of; still on hold pending city approvals etc.

222-22l: Pond Inlet: screening (and licence) on hold pending receipt of more information.

\*as with Cape Dorset, this application could be saved for the new Nunavut Water Board if they are looking for projects to test their new responsibilities on.
