The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Amendment of water license 3BM-CAP1925 to accommodate construction of the new Mechanical Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). The objective of the project is for the WWTP to meet the long-term needs of the community.

A complete description of the project proposal reviewed by the NPC can be accessed online using the link below. The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) previously screened the works and activities associated with the current proposal, including quarrying and operation of a type B water license (NIRB FILE NO. 06QN062).

The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to the project because it includes the construction of a new wastewater management plant.

The above-noted project proposal requires screening by the NIRB under section 12.4.3 of the Nunavut Agreement as amended because it is for a component or activity that was not part of the original or previously amended proposal
