The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) acknowledges receipt on September 8th, 2006 of your 2005 Annual Report as required by Part B, Item 1 of your water licence. The NWB would like to communicate that the Annual Report acts as a reporting mechanism that enables the NWB to understand activities that have taken place during the year being reported. The Annual Report also acts as a preparatory tool in the development of terms and conditions that may be developed in a successive licence. The NWB would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the Hamlet's recent efforts through its current application for a new sewage lagoon facility. The NWB is looking forward to the review of the stand-alone design document as per my letter addressed September 20th 2006.

It should be understood that the expiry date for Cape Dorset's municipal licence is set to take place on August 31st 2007. The Hamlet of Cape Dorset is encouraged to initiate the licensing process of all other municipal facilities (solid waste facilities, water intake facilities etc.) six (6) months prior to licence expiry (March 1st, 2007). The NWB understands the capacity and resource constraints the Hamlet may have with developing and providing water licence application materials. The NWB encourages the Hamlet of Cape Dorset to contact the Department of Community and Government Services with the Government of Nunavut for assistance.
