The Department of Community and Government Services is managing the Cape Dorset 3 Cell Sewage lagoon project in Nunavut. This correspondence is to up-date Environment Canada on actions taken place to date as per the Inspector's Directions.

Dillon has completed the detailed design drawings for the 75% submission review. The tender, contract and specifications have been received by our office. In consultation with the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, Dillon is preparing the detailed cost estimate of this project. The design drawings will be submitted post this consultation.

We expect to be in a position to tender this work in early 2006 and believe that the construction can be completed by the end of the summer 2006 construction season and thus meet the deadlines you have stipulated. We hope that you will acknowledge that we are making progress in addressing this issue.
