The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on February 17, 2003 of your water licence application for the Hamlet of Clyde River, submitted on your behalf by Ferguson Simek Clark. Your application included the following items:

- supplementary questionnaire
- Information for the Water License Application
- Appendix 1 - maps and drawings
- Appendix 2 – Hazardous Materials Spill Reports

- Clyde River Solid Waste Facility Siting Study – Final Report – Dillon, July 8, 2002

By copy of this letter to Ferguson Simek Clark we formally request the \$30.00 application fee in cheque form, made payable to “Receiver General for Canada”.

This project is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Planning Commission and by the Nunavut Impact Review Board due to its municipal status.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a notice of your application is required. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take “...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings].”

Accordingly, a notice in both English and Inuktitut will be posted for a period of 30 days, with the local establishments in Clyde River.
