I am writing today to advise you of the up-coming Water License Inspection on the Municipal Water Treatment, Bulk Waste Management and Waste Treatment Facilities in Clyde River on the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2014.

As you may be aware Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) is responsible for ensuring compliance with, and enforcement of, the Nunavut Water and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act. As such, our Inspectors conduct annual Inspections in each community as well as Exploration Camps, Mine sites, Research Camps and other activities conducted on Crown Lands, Commissioner's (Municipal) Lands as well as Inuit Owned Lands throughout the Nunavut Territory.
