Hamlet is operating their facilities following these manuals. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT THE LICENSEE DEEMS USEFUL: Hamlet follows CGS extending sampling program for water, wastewater and leachate sampling and testing using Caduecon Lab in Ottawa. They maintains CGS report card in order to manage their Environmental facilities more effectively and productively.

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FOLLOW-UP REGARDING INSPECTION/COMPLIANCE CONCERNS:

Hamlet works closely with the newly formed Water Licence Compliance Group (WLCG) to deal with any water licence compliancy. Currently Hamlet has a new Water Licence # 3BM-CLY1419.
