

Re: Supplementary water licence for Hamlet of Coral Harbour

The Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Coral Harbour is requesting to use a lake which is to the east of the arena for disposing 2,000 cubic metres of blast rock. This lake used to be a solid waste disposal site; when the military was here in the 1940's they dumped 45 gallon barrels into the lake. Efforts were made to try to clean up the area. A terrific job was done on the land, but in the lake there still are signs of debris. This is despite using a backhoe with a large bucket to remove whatever could be taken out. The Hamlet is proposing to cover the area with blast rock to remove the unsightly appearance. The total volume of blast rock would be around 2,000 cubic metres at the northwestern side of the lake.

We are now seeking your approval to use the lake which we have indicated as a disposal site for blast rock. Should you require clarification you can contact me at (867) 925-8867.


