We would like to find out where this contaminate is coming from before commercial caribou harvesting starts. Which we believe would be November of this year.

There was some testing done early spring of this year, however, we are requesting to have another testing before caribou commercial harvesting begins. We would like to find out where the source is coming from. On Monday Aiviit HTO held Annual General Meeting October 22, 2001. That's when we were asked to seek for testers before harvesting starts.
