

Executive Summary

The Hamlet of Gjoa Haven is submitting an application for renewal of the Hamlet's water licence (Licence Number: NWB3GJO0409) as the water licence expired on January 31, 2009. Dillon Consulting Limited has been retained by Community and Government Services, Government of Nunavut to complete the application on behalf of the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven.

As well as the completed application form and plan for compliance, the Nunavut Water Board is requesting the following supporting documentation:

- Operation and Maintenance Manual for the Sewage Lagoon and Solid Waste Sites
- Spill Contingency Plan
- Abandonment and Restoration Plan

Due to the need for repairs and upgrades to the sewage lagoon and solid waste sites, these documents cannot be completed until an appropriate course of action with regards to these facilities has been determined. We recognize that the repairs and modifications are subject to capital funding by the Government of Nunavut.

Included in this application is the compliance plan as requested by the Nunavut Water Board. The purpose of the compliance plan is to develop an estimated schedule for when repairs and upgrades will be completed, as well as when all other required supporting documentation will be completed. The plan has been developed based on the best available information at the time of submission. Reports to follow will be submitted according to the schedules stated in the plan. We trust that the information provided in this application will be sufficient for conditional water licence approval, with full-term approval pending the submission of the required documents.
