

Hamlet of Gjoa Haven, N.W.T.

By-Law No. 67

A By-Law to regulate the disposal of garbage at the Municipal dump pursuant to the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c.H-1, s.86.

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven in the Northwest Territories deems it expedient to regulate the dumping of garbage within municipal boundaries by personnel other than Hamlet employees.

NOW THEREFORE The Hamlet of Gjoa Haven at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This By-law may be cited as "Regulation of Municipal Dump By-law".

INTERPRETATIONS

2. In this by-law;

"council"	means the Council of the Hamlet;
"Hamlet"	means the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven
"user"	means a government user, commercial user, or non-commercial user;
"permit"	means a permit issued by the Hamlet as per attached Schedule A;
"garbage"	means garbage, refuse or other waste;
"garbage service"	means the pick-up and disposal of garbage;
"commercial user"	means a commercial or industrial firm, organization, company, partnership, or sole proprietorship, whether incorporated or unincorporated, which uses garbage services;

"government user"

means the Government of Canada, the Government of the Northwest Territories, Crown Corporations, the Northwest Territories Housing Corporation, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, the Hamlet, or any agency of any of them, which uses garbage services.;

"excess garbage"

means any garbage not stowed in the barrels or other containers provided;

"schedule"

means a schedule attached to and forming part of this by-law.

REGULATIONS

3. Subject to the provisions of this by-law;

- 1) No person, commercial user or government user shall use a municipal dump unless authorized to do so by a permit issued by the Hamlet.
- 2) Any person, commercial or government users disposing of garbage at a municipal dump must so in accordance with the restricted areas as detailed in this by-law.
- 3) The restricted areas shall be designated as follows; as per attached schedule D.
 - a) sewage disposal pit;
 - b) honeybag storage site;
 - c) old wreck disposal site;
 - d) combustible waste site;
- 4) No person, commercial or government user shall burn garbage unless authorized to do so by Hamlet.
- 5) The hours of operation for the dump shall be as authorized and approved by Council.

Payment and Penalties

4. Per attached Schedules B and C.

- 1) Cost of permits per attached Schedule B.
- 2) Penalty for noncompliance with this by-law per attached Schedule C.

REVIEW

5. This by-law shall be reviewed each fiscal year.

Schedule B

Cost of Permit

1. All users, authorized by permit, to dump garbage at the municipal dump must first pay the following permit fee:
 - a) \$75.00 per dump trip.

Schedule C

Penalty for Non-Compliance

1. Any user found dumping garbage at the municipal dump, contrary to this by-law, is liable an summary conviction to a fine not to exceed:
 - a) for an individual, up to a maximum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), and
 - b) for a corporation, up to a maximum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5, 000.00).
