Licence Number: Nunavut Water Licence 3BM-GJO 1318, and
3BM-GJO 1318/ Amendment No. 1, dated Sep 16, 2015**

Please find this Amendment to the Renewal Application of the Water Licence 3BM- GJO 1318 for the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven, submitted June 06, 2018.

- Location and description of undertaking facilities for water, sewage and waste - same as existing
- Nature of interest in the land and authority – same as existing
- NIRB screening on existing Licence - not required (Ref. 13UN032)
- Primary undertaking of water use, sewage waste disposal for Municipal – the same as existing
 Water intake – from Swan Lake using twin intake pumps and same allowable annual quantity
 Sewage waste disposal – at the new sewage lagoon (Amendment No.1, Sep 16, 2015)
 Solid waste disposal i.e. municipal, metal, hazardous bulky waste – same as previous licence
- Environmental impacts of the undertaking and mitigation plan- not required as identified previously.

- Contaminated soils, spills remediation and sludge drying scopes - not included in the current licence. Inclusion of these scopes will be requested once such facilities are installed and available for uses. GN CGS is working with a Study Project to determine the facility requirements, capacity and feasibility for waste facility improvement, upgrade or expansion for activities next 20 years.
