Re: <u>Application Acknowledgement and Additional Information Required for the Government of Nunavut – Community and Government Services' "New Sewage Lagoon" Project Proposal</u>

Dear Mr. Rostant:

On July 10, 2013 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received the Government of Nunavut – Community and Government Services' (GN-CGS) "New Sewage Lagoon" project proposal from GN-CGS. The NIRB has assigned this project proposal file number **13UN032**.

All documents received and pertaining to this project proposal include:

- NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in English, Inuktitut and Inuinnaqtun;
- Design Development Draft Report;
- Non-technical Project Proposal summary in English, Inuktitut and Inuinnagtun; and
- Figure 1- General Site Plan.

The NIRB has undertaken a preliminary completeness check and finds that your project proposal does *not* contain sufficient information for the NIRB to permit proper screening. Specifically, the NIRB is requesting submission of a completed *NIRB Part 2 Project Specific Information Form* in English by **August 1, 2013**, with particular attention paid to the following points:

- Confirmation of construction activities that have taken place to date;
- Clarification that Figure 1- General Site Plan Map is the location and number of sewage lagoon cells proposed for construction;
- Confirmation of the proposed design of the new sewage lagoon including but not limited to the following elements:
 - type of lagoon (i.e., storage lagoon, short or long-detention);

- o location of sewage lagoon effluent discharge point (i.e., effluent discharged into existing wetland area or new wetland area);
- o sewage lagoon infrastructure (e.g., access roads, berms, liner, decant structure, etc.); and
- confirmed capacity of new sewage lagoon;
- Type of waste anticipated to be generated from construction of the new sewage lagoon and decommissioning of the existing sewage lagoon and waste management plan;
- Confirmation of decommissioning process for existing lagoon; and
- *Public consultation meeting summaries.*

If GN-CGS determines that the time needed to supply the required information is significantly greater than 2 weeks, the Board requests that written notification and an anticipated date for submission be supplied prior to the August 1, 2013 deadline.
