As per your order to the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven to implement measures to prevent the discharge of raw sewage from the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven Sewage Lagoon, the following actions have been completed:

- consultation between the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven and the Government of Nunavut

 Community Government and Services has taken place
 - -the berms in the area of the discharge have been reinforced and built back up
 which appears to have stopped the flow of raw sewage into the stream leading
 to the ocean
 - -the area is being monitored on a regular basis and the effected area appears to be drying up in a suitable manner and the water in the stream seems to be cleaner
- further analysis of the Sewage Lagoon operation will take place with the Hamlet

of Gjoa Haven and the Regional Municipal Planning Engineer in the near future
