Please accept this letter as notification that the 2000 and 2001 Annual Reports as required under licence NWB3GJO9904 Part B, Item 1 have been reviewed. I apologize for the lateness of this letter, but was pleased to see that you had completed these reports when they were initially received.

The Water Licence requires that tabular summaries of all data generated under the "Surveillance Network Program" be included in the Annual Report. Please note that the samples collected by the Water Resources Officer are not intended to fulfil the license requirements and that the Hamlet should conduct an independent sampling program. The Report states that the Operations and Maintenance Manual and Report on Ownership of Abandoned Facilities have not been completed. Since these reports were required in July and December of 1999, respectively, they must be submitted for approval of the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) as soon as possible.

As modifications to the water supply system are planned, please ensure that the NWB is notified in writing of the proposed modifications at least sixty days prior to beginning the work. In addition, site plans of the modifications must be submitted to the NWB within ninety days of completion of the work.

Annual reports constitute a critical source of information regarding municipal water use and waste disposal available to the NWB and regulatory agencies, and we appreciate your efforts to comply with this requirement. Please ensure that future reports are submitted prior to March 31 of the year following the calendar year reported. Should you have any
