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## Strategic Infrastructure Fund – Preliminary Project Brief

Community: Gjoa Haven Project: Water System

Explanation

The Gjoa Haven water source comprises a small natural lake used as an annual reservoir, a summer fill line and traditional truck fill station. Recently, there has been a blood worm infestation in the Gjoa Haven system. Although there are no health risks associated with this, it has a detrimental aesthetic impact.

In 2003/04, the Department of Community Government and Transportation will be constructing a water treatment plant. In 2004/05, it is suggested that a permanent pipeline be constructed to the source (Swan Lake) along with a pumphouse at Swan Lake.

The scope of work contemplated under the SIF is the permanent pipeline. A design already exists and is ready for construction in 2004/05.

The estimated cost for this project is approximately \$4.5 Million.

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
