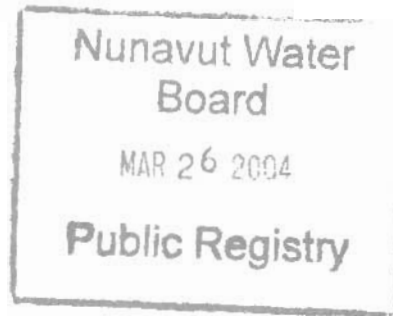

**Re: Notice of Modification, NWB3GJO0308**

To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven, we are submitting this *Notice of Modification* with respect to Water License NWB3GJO0308.

The proposed modification is to allow a permanent pipeline and road from the newly constructed Water Treatment Plant to the water source lake (Swan Lake). At Swan Lake there will be a permanent intake pump house and emergency truck fill point along with a water intake pipe. This system replaces the existing seasonal use pipeline and intake structure at Swan Lake. The new intake will be located at depth rather than near the surface of the water. The intake pipe will be weighted and covered with rip rap and will lie on the lake bottom, and the pipe will still have intake screens to prevent fish entry. There will be no change to the amount of water withdrawn from Swan Lake resulting from this modification.

Attached is Figure #1, Project 02-0602, that shows the plan and profile views of the proposed intake structure. The Government of Nunavut intends to tender these works publicly. A set of pre-tender drawings and specifications will be forwarded to you for review in the next few weeks. Please do not hesitate to call with any questions that you may have regarding this Notice of Modification.
