No modification and /or major maintenance work was carried out on waste disposal facility during this reporting period. The surface water storage ditch was expanded a bit. The Solid waste management (land fill) project is still on hold due to funding constraints.

Hamlet has a plan to abandon the existing landfill site. Once the new solid waste management facility is built and commissioned, the existing site will only be abandoned and restored. But due to funding, this new project is on hold. No abandonment and restoration work was carried out for any licensed facilities during this reporting year.

The hydrology assessment studies of the primary and secondary water sources are

complete. The final reports are available.

Current waste management site is the concern of the Nunavut Water Board and INAC.

Hamlet is planning to expand the area of the ditch to increase water storage capacity in next summer.

O&M manuals have been prepared for the existing non- engineered sewage lagoon and waste management facility and submitted to NWB. Whereas water supply system is being operated following the guidelines of the existing O&M manual. The new manual will be ready once the plant is upgraded.

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The Hamlet is following the direction of the Water Licence Compliance Working Group (WLCWG). Hamlet is also planning to implement CGS new report card to operate their environmental facilities more effectively.

Hamlet has a new licence. They are engaged in summer sampling program following CGS established protocol.
