



Lastly, the Board would like to remind the Licensee that without consistent environmental monitoring and proper identification of the samples, the Board and other interested parties possess few means to properly assess the environmental performance of the Hamlet facilities.

Following this, the Board requires by **October 29, 2017** the resubmission of monitoring results for years 2015 and 2016; results should be identified with the monitoring station number according to Part J, Item 1 of the Water Licence. In the same submission, the Licensee should explain the reasons why the sampling frequency at Monitoring Stations GRI-2 and GRI-4 differs from that outlined under Part J, Item 1 of the Licence.
