Just a few questions regarding the Hall Beach Application:

1. Can you provide the most up-to-date versions of the Operation and Maintenance Manuals/Management Plans for the following:

- Water Supply Facility: Submitted, no change
- Solid Waste Facility: Submitted, No change
- Sewage Facility: Two lagoons, One lagoon was lined and waiting for the O&M . We will get it at any time.
- Spill Contingency Plan: Submitted, no Change
- QA/QC Plan: Submitted, no change
- will an Abandonment and Restoration Plan be developed for the old Solid Waste Facility that is being replaced?: We are not ready yet.

2. Can you clarify water volume requested? Currently the Hamlet is at the Licence limit of 35k m3 water use, and the application has contracting information that is requesting 36,829 m3. I'd recommend at least 40k.; 45K is good number.

3. Can you provide documentation, or a summary of the conversation with the CIRNAC Inspector that negated Licence condition D-6, requiring Toxicity testing of sewage effluent.: Due to complexity of shipping toxicity samples to Winnipeg lab, we have stopped. There is no written commitment. I do not think they could do that.

I understand that some of this information may be supplied at a later date, i.e. some management plans may be updated. However, if you can supply what Plans are currently in use by the Hamlet, so they can be included in the application for review. From what I see, these Plans (if we have them) will likely need to be updated.

No management plan on hand yet expect:

1. Feasibility study of Solidwaste project is at the final stage. The document could be submitted only when it is available in next 3 to 4 months.
2. The Lined lagoon cell leaks and we are planning to repair this summer.
