WATER LAKE AT HALL BEACH RADAR STATION

The present is intended to give you advance notice of a potentially serious problem with the water lake at Hall Beach. This summer, our operation and maintenance contractor at the site reported some seepage from the dam surrounding the water lake. Further investigation from their engineering department revealed that the problem was serious. Preliminary indications are that if no repairs are done during summer 1994, the water level may go down low enough for the lake to completely freeze over the winter.

A detailed engineering study will soon be available from our contractor and a copy will be forwarded to your office for information. Once you have digested the report, I propose a meeting be arranged to discuss the proposed solutions and cost sharing of the repairs.
