SUBJECT OBJET

Hall Beach - Water Supply Planning Study

On behalf of the Environmental Protection Branch (EPB) I have reviewed the planning study prepared by Oliver, Mangione, McCalla & Associates Ltd., and offer the following comments:

- The recommendation made by the report is rehabilitation of the existing
  reservoir, rather than construction of a new one at an alternate site. In the
  event this recommendation is not implemented, one factor that would have to
  be considered in connection with a new site is the abandonment of the existing
  reservoir and restoration of the drainage of Lake C.
- Figure 1 should indicate a compass direction.
- Details are not provided on the remainder of Lake C above the dam with respect to depth, outflows, and associated fisheries resources in this lake or downstream waters. This information should be included in any proposal to carry out work on the dam. Has stability of the dam been evaluated?
- The last inspection reported ice depths of 11 feet or 3.34 m in the winter.
   Given that the deepest area of the reservoir is 4.1m the figure of 250,000 m<sup>3</sup> may be optimistic as the winter water volume.
