Water Licencing for the Hamlet of Hall Beach

Ref: Conversation with Lucy Magee, November 4, 1997.

- 1. As a bit of background information, a municipal water licence is a requirement of the NWT Waters Act. The Nunavut Land Claims Agreement allowed for the establishment of the Nunavut Water Board (NWB). This Board has the authority to issue water licences in the Nunavut Settlement Area. The Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development is responsible for enforcing these licences. The Hamlet of Hall Beach does not have a water licence.
- 2. A water licence application was left with your predecessor, but no application was made.
- 3. Enclosed is an additional application form. I would ask that you complete it and send it to:
