Please find enclosed the final report for the Hall Beach Sewage lagoon "upgrade". The report basically recommends the construction of diversion ditches and creation of a "wetlands" area.

There are a number of important future considerations:

1. The report indicates that the storage capacity of the lagoons will not meet the 20 year ice pack storage volume demand – The Department and the Hamlet will monitor the situation of the coming years and implement a solution as required (likely increasing capacity of existing lagoons).
2. Although the report states that theoretically, treatment will be sufficient, there is no monitoring program currently in place – As part of the Water Board Licensing procedures, it is considered prudent to contain provisions for various SNP locations along the system. It is the Department's and Hamlet's intention to pursue obtaining a Water License over the coming months.
