Because water may be taken from an alternate water source, and considering the waste deposit implications, we will again need a written request and approval for this, addressing water use and waste disposal activities.

Can you please provide with this request, the following information:

the planned schedule,

approximately what volume of water may be drawn from the "adjacent seasonal tundra ponds,"

the Spill report # they are referring to,

what will be done with the excavated material from the lagoon bottom,

will the water quality be tested before discharge.

what erosion measures will be put in place,

and will any monitoring be conducted downstream of the discharge.

Although this discharge is being considered "part of the spill" reported earlier this month, some mitigation measures should be put in place being that we know it is coming.
