Scope of works for Reporting wetland waste water effluent quality of the Hamlet of Kimmirut for three years to determine wetland efficiency by an Engineer registered with NAPEG.

- 1. Visit to the site, establish the sampling points with coordinates and present in the map. Access to the sampling site to be arranged and accompanied by the Government of Nunavut or the Hamlet.
- 2. Train the Hamlet staff for collecting, shipping and handling of samples.
- 3. Provide the training to the operators of the Sewage Lagoon on the Operational technique throughout the year.
- 4. Present the O&M guidelines of the Sewage Lagoon and the monitoring Program to the Council at a meeting during the site visit.
- 5. Review and Compile data by the Hamlet staff. Sampling will be done for three years starting from the year after of commissioning the lagoons expected from 2015. Hamlet to pay sample shipping and testing for all sampling events and test results to be forwarded to the consultant for evaluation.
- 6. Prepare an annual monitoring test Evaluation report each year (total three years) and one final summary report for the sampling program undertaken by the Hamlet.
- 7. Each year's evaluation report will be attached with the Hamlet Annual Report to NWB.
