

Re: Compliance Issues with Water Licence N5L4-1441

Ref: Letter dated August 21, 1997 to Mayor Kowisaw Arlooktoo (attached).

- I would like to take this opportunity to bring to your attention a number of outstanding issues that the Hamlet of Kimmirut presently faces with respect to its current water licence, N5L4-1441.
- Water Licences are a legal requirement under the NWT Waters Act and are a necessary administrative tool designed to regulate water use and the wastes generated by the use of that water in addition to municipal activities that may affect negative effect on water resources (i.e. waste disposal sites).
- 3. The Hamlet of Kimmirut holds a valid water licence. However, within all water licences there are terms and conditions that must be followed. Over the past number of years, the Hamlet has not adequately met these terms and conditions.
- The matter has escalated to the point where Mayor Arlooktoo was advised of the situation and requested to address the situation. To date, no reply has been received.
- 5. This office has always endeavoured to work with the Licensee to address non-compliance issues.
- It is my hope that you will take this opportunity to address the various issues of noncompliance in a timely fashion and that further violations of the NWT Waters Act can be avoided.
