- Follow up submittals made between May 08, 2014 May 28, 2015 as requested
- NWB has confirmed the completeness of the application on Feb 02, 2015 that met all requirements and sent for stakeholders review, due by 30 days to NWB.
- NIRB has sent review reply on Feb 26, 2015 with comments: 'that do not require a public hearing under Section 13.7.3 of NLCA Schedule 12-1 (5)'
- NPC has responded on May 27, 2015 with comments:
 "the project is located outside the boundaries of the two approved land use plan currently administered by the NPC"
- Responded from NWB time to time (June 18, 2015 Sep 28, 2015) on our queries about the status of the Licence is that "Daft is under review".

In accordance with the practice and policy, the Board has advised an Amendment Application submission 90 days ahead of its expiry, with the aim to give sufficient time to process a renew or amendment to the existing Licence, unfortunately, no indication of how many months will actually to wait for an amendment process. Also at this long excess period, the Licence remains



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expired and operation must cease or the Licensee will be in contravention of the NLCA and NWNSRTA, but the Licensee remains in obligations imposed by the Licence.

In accordance to the NWB letter dated Feb 02, 2015, the application has met the requirements for the amendment process, which indicates completeness of the application. We request the Nunavut Water Board to update the status of the Licence for us to reply to users and involve parties for development works to water and wastewater.
