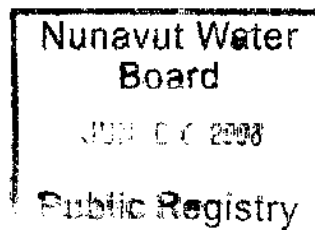

**Whereas:** Many communities have items from the Land Fill site that end up in the residential area of town.

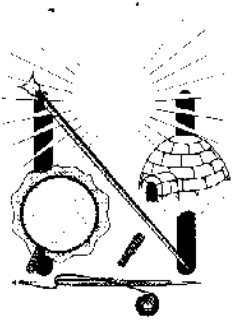
**Whereas:** Very few communities have funding to provide fencing for their landfill sites.
