Subject: Sewer Lagoon

This is to give everyone an update on the progress with regard to the Decanting of our Sewer Lagoon. The plan was that this process would take about 10 days and the contractor would be in to do the work Necessary and repair what needed to be done, we have been monitoring the process on a daily bases, we also have been running the pump for approximately 16 to 18 hours a day.

The level in the Lagoon Is only dropping at about 1 to 1.5 inches per day, at this rate we will never be ready to have the work done before the snow fly's.

For this reason after talking to Tom Livingston we will start pumping for a period of 24 hours a day, remember we are still using the lagoon for dumping this means we put several gallons back in. We have also decided to activate the old Lagoon and will start using it for dumping on Monday August 16th 2010. This will be a temporary process and I will advise everyone of the progress. This will speed up the process.
