I am sorry this reply is not 11 months late, the notice I received requested a review of this file by June 24, 2006. I do not control when the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) sends me files for comment. If this project was submitted under a different file name previously the project would have received a response which said that this file can continue if it can avoid the archaeological sites in the area, and you should have been provided a list of the locations for archaeological sites in an "attachment 1" since this is the information regularly sent to the NWB. I also do not control what NWB sends out. There is a small chance that I might have missed responding to this file (if it was submitted previously under a different file name), but this rarely happens since the NWB allows reviewers a month to comment.

I have been working very well with Community Planners from CGS for over a year now (Lillian Chau, Rebecca Jerram, Adule Chris, Peter Scholz) and there is an informal agreement that I will review any of CGS's planning/development requests so that situations like this can be avoided. This informal agreement was supposed to turn in to a MOU but didn't because the spearhead for that agreement left her position. The section/ division in CGS that I have had this understanding with clearly isn't the same as the section that you work for or this problem could have easily been avoided. While it doesn't help in this situation please feel free to contact me about any future development / ground disturbances you are proposing. (I will be in the field for most of July until mid August).

If survey crews are going out this summer, I suspect that the first step would be to locate the sites closest to the farm – I did a search of about 2 minutes of latitude and 2 minutes of longitude- and then to slightly adjust the position of the soil farm to avoid (a minimum of 30 metres) the sites if need be. I would be happy to further our discussion on this matter so that the site is protected and that the soil farm construction can happen.
