The waste management area was segregated; however no hazardous waste area was noted. Sewage is released directly into the environment and runs to the ocean along a melt water flow channel. Municipal wastes have not been burned in three years. The Municipality is operating outside the terms and conditions of their water license and contrary to the Nunavut Water and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act.
