Please see attached water licence renewal for the Hamlet of Naujaat. Please note the following terms and conditions of the water licence renewal are due:

PART F: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

1. The Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval in writing, within ninety (90) days of issuance of the Licence, an Operation and Maintenance Plan for the Water Supply Facility. **(due April 27, 2021)**
3. The Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval in writing, within ninety (90) days of issuance of the Licence, an Operation and Maintenance Plan for the Solid Waste Disposal Facility prepared in accordance with the "Guidelines for the Preparation of an Operation and Maintenance Manual for Sewage and Solid Waste Disposal Facilities in the Northwest Territories" (1996). **(due April 27, 2021)**
4. The Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval in writing, within six (6) months of issuance of the Licence, a Long-term Solid Waste Management Plan for the Hamlet of Naujaat that provides definitive objectives for building new or upgrading existing solid Waste management infrastructure. **(due July 27, 2021)**
5. The Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval in writing, within ninety (90) days of issuance of the Licence, a Spill Contingency Plan that addresses all Water Supply, Sewage and Solid Waste Disposal Facilities / operations, including Hazardous materials, in the event of a spill. **(due April 27, 2021)**

PART G: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO CLOSURE AND RECLAMATION

6. The Licensee shall submit for review, within six (6) months of Licence issuance, a Closure and Reclamation Report for the old Solid Waste Site used prior to 2002. This report is to be stamped by an Engineer and describe the history of the site and its decommissioning, and also the Engineer's assessment of whether further reclamation is required at the site to mitigate the possibility of contamination to surrounding freshwater systems. **(due July 27, 2021)**

PART H: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO MONITORING PROGRAM

12. The Licensee shall submit to the Board for review, within ninety (90) days of the issuance of the Licence, a Quality Assurance/Quality Control Plan based on the guidance document Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Control (QC) Guidelines For Use by Class "B" Licensees in Collecting Representative Water Samples in the Field and for Submission of a QAQC Plan, INAC (1996). The Plan shall include a covering letter from an accredited laboratory confirming acceptance of the Plan for the monitoring and analyses to be performed under the Licence. **(due April 27, 2021)**
