Further to our conversation about potential enforcement issues relative to this file, please note that Environment Canada would only enter into enforcement action if there was a deposit of a deleterious substances of any type in water frequented by fish..(please see Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*)

With respect to the contractor completing work without a valid water license, it may be more appropriate that the Board contact the INAC inspector and refer this information and file to them. Then, INAC enforcement could take what ever actions they see fit.
