Dear Mr. Dwyer,

The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Nunavut (TIN) – Municipal Works Division is submitting this notification of proposed modifications to the water licence 3BM-NAU2333 for the Sewage Disposal Facility on behalf of the Municipality of Naujaat.

The new Sewage Disposal Facility is planned for construction from June 2027 to October 2028. The design has changed partly since the previous amendment application in December 2022.

The following changes are proposed for the new Sewage Disposal Facility:

- New access road path to the sewage lagoon to avoid the nearby solar facility
- Two truck sewage disposal chutes instead of one will be installed to improve operations
- The active volume of the lagoon adjusted from 104,550 cubic metres to 126,900 cubic metres to meet demands for 20 years from the new commissioning date
- Minor changes to the footprint of the lagoon to accommodate the above changes
