Hi Bhabesh,

Going through submissions and correspondence between GN and NWB, i noticed some items that should be addressed prior the application is deemed to be complete for review:

Although I acknowledge that there is a small Section - Plan for Compliance in your Cover letter dated May 13, 2014, however, this Plan for Compliance is not informative and functional. Given the fact that the previous Licence included many items to be addressed, the Plan for Compliance was supposed to demonstrate the measures the Licensee will undertake, including an implementation short-term and long-term schedule, to achieve full compliance with the conditions of this Licence. I will really appreciate if your template from Clyde River or Qikiqtarjuak is used for the completion of this Plan for Compliance.

The Plan for Compliance shall indicate when all outstanding information including updated O&M Plans for Wastewater Treatment Plant (that doesn't have any indication of when and by whom was completed), or Water Distribution Facility (I am not sure whether the 1987 Truckfill Station O&M Plan is still an appropriate Plan for this purpose) could be submitted.

The July 18, 2014 letter states that your constructor is waiting at the field. However, i don't really know what is required from the Board at this point if the licence is not valid? The Board can't issue any kind of authorization under the expired licence. To date, the application was not deemed to be complete for the public review distribution. Once a fully functional Plan is submitted to the Board it will be distributed for 30 day comments. Than we will go from there and do our best to finalize document asap.
