### Subject: Water Licence (Type A), Duval River, Municipality of Pangnirtung (17-HCAA- 00779)

The Fisheries Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada received your Type A water licence renewal proposal which has been reviewed under the *Fisheries Act* and the *Species at Risk Act*.

Based on the information provided, your proposal has been identified as a project where a *Fisheries Act* Authorization is not required given that serious harm to fish can be avoided by following standard measures. Your project, as proposed, would not be considered to need an authorization from the Program under the *Fisheries Act* in order to proceed. In order to comply with the *Act*, it is recommended that you follow our guidance tools which can be found at the following website (<http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/measures-mesures/measures-mesures-eng.html>). It remains your responsibility to meet the requirements of other federal, provincial and municipal agencies.

Following the hydrology study that is to be conducted, should the proposed water taking be likely to result in a reduction in either the instantaneous flow or wetted width of Duval River, further advice from DFO should be sought.

Should your plans change or if you have omitted some information in your proposal such that your proposal meets the criteria for a site specific review, as described on our website ([www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/index-eng.html](http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/index-eng.html)), you should submit the request for review form that is also available on the website.

Should you have any questions or concerns about the compliance of your proposal with the *Fisheries Act*, and/or those prohibitions of the *Species at Risk Act* that apply to listed aquatic species, you may wish to engage an environmental professional familiar with measures to avoid impacts to fish and fish habitat ([www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/env-pro-eng.html](http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/env-pro-eng.html)).
