Thank you for your Department's reply regarding our comments on the above-noted study. Presently, approval from the NWB is not required to proceed to the next phase. To ensure compliance with Part C, Item 4 of Licence No N5L4-1447, the licensee will be required to submit for approval by the Board, the final proposal for upgrading the sewage disposal system including any information gathered from additional studies and tests. Because the proposed modification is inconsistent with the existing terms of the licence, the licensee will also be required to apply for an amendment to the existing licence as changes to Part C, Item 1, will be required. The application for amendment should include a completed application form, accompanied by the thirty (30) dollar application fee with a cheque payable the Receiver General for Canada. For further information in this regard, do not hesitate to contact David Porter, NWB Licence Administrator.

Regarding consultation, to ensure that a thorough review is done of all plans and studies submitted in support of a licence, the NWB distributed these plans for comments to other regulatory authorities. When possible, these agencies submit their comments to the Board which in turn relays them to the licensec. In this case the Board did not receive comments from DFO, but for this project to proceed a specific approval under the Fisheries Act in the form of an authorization from the Department of Fisheries and Oceans will be required. In accordance with the Public Health Act-Public Sewage System Regulations, Part 1, Item (3)
