Subject: Water testing in Pangnirtung

Hello Phyllis,

I originally sent these questions below to Andrew Keim, INAC Water Resources Officer at the Iqaluit Regional Office, who has recommended I address them to you. He indicated the NWB issues the licenses and then INAC monitors compliance with the terms of the licenses. He also informed me that once the documents are completed (report written) it will be sent to the NWB and posted on the website for public viewing. I have seen the Registry link on your site but the Pangnirtung related information for the last 2 years is not accessible. I would appreciate it if you could simply send me that from your end.

Further to the recent articles in the Nunatsiaq News pertaining to the ongoing toxic burning of garbage at the Pangnirtung municipal Waste Disposal Site, I would appreciate it if you would kindly address a number of questions. These questions pertain to water quality and testing at the Pangnirtung municipal Waste Disposal Site (aka the Pang dump) and the Pang municipal drinking water reservoir.

1. What is the date for the Pang water license renewal and the Schedule for inspection prior to license renewal?
2. Could you please clarify for me the thresholds for licensing of each of the contaminants being tested for at the Pang dump?
3. Could you please clarify for me the thresholds for licensing of each of the contaminants being tested for at the municipal drinking water reservoir?
4. What contaminants were found in leachate from ash following the last dump burnings in Iqaluit and what were the requisite mitigating treatments?
5. I presume past Pang test results are available to the public. May I please have a copy of the comprehensive results from the last testing From the Pang dump and water reservoir?
6. What were the sampling locations at the Pang dump? (I presume The west side near the small intermittent stream and north side facing the fiord?)
7. Has the leachate from the Pang dump ever required treatment And if so what mitigating treatment was done?
8. What is the anticipated date for the next leachate testing?

Thank you for your valuable time and efforts in this matter Phyllis.
