The Hamlet of Kugaaruk is pleased to submit to Nunavut Water Board the attached application package for the renewal of its licence No. 1BR-KRK1112 as stated above. Copies of required reports are attached herewith as requested for your review and requirements. Separate application for amendment of land farm facility has been submitted by our consultant 'Tetra Consultants' on behalf of the hamlet of Kugaaruk. Another amendment application for the new intake pumphouse and water treatment facility is underway to be submitted by our consultant 'William Engineers' on behalf of the hamlet of Kugaaruk.

We realize that it has been late in submitting our renewal application; however, an amendment request has already been submitted by our consultant 'Tetra Consultant' on our behalf for land farm facility which is a part of our Water Licence. With the help of Government of Nunavut though Community and Government Services, we have undertaken a comprehensive waste management monitoring program which has led to improvement of sewage and solid waste site facilities, wetland and effluent discharge.

Our annual monitoring program for water, sewage and solid waste has been in effect since summer 2012. Sample test result has shown excellent control on contamination parameters within allowable limits comprising BOD, TSS, E-coli and Toxicity components. There is no change in Operation and Maintenance plan, however we are looking forward to have an updated manual and will be submitted to NWB once ready.

We hope that Nunavut Water Board will find our supporting documents valuable to water licence renewal process. In anticipation of the need to consider our application beyond Dec 31, 2012 expiry date, we are requesting a 90 days extension of the current licence in order to receive the full Renewal Licence.
