## RE: NWB FILE # 3BM-PEL0712 – Hamlet of Kugaaruk Spill Plan for Sewage & Solid Waste Sites

Dear Mr. Dwyer:

The Government of Nunavut, Department of Environment (DOE) has reviewed the Spill Plan for the Sewage and Solid Waste Sites for the Hamlet of Kugaaruk. The DOE has the following comments and recommendations based on the *Environmental Protection Act.* 

## **GENERAL**

The Spill Contingency Plan should include:

- An inventory and the location of response and clean up equipment available to implement the plan. This includes your equipment as well as any to be used by another person responding to the spill on your behalf.
- A detailed site map that is intended to illustrate the facilities relationship to
  other areas that may be affected by the spill. The map should be to scale
  and be large enough to include the location of your facility, nearby
  buildings or facilities, roads, culverts, drainage patters, and any nearby
  bodies of water.
