I would like to mention that the water crossing towards Salmon River is the priority project of the Hamlet. Once the design package for this water crossing is ready, the new licence will be amended.

Hamlet already paid \$30 application fees payable to Receiver General for Canada along with the previous application. Therefore no fee is being paid with this application.
