The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on January 20, 2003 of your water licence renewal application for the Hamlet of Pond Inlet, submitted on your behalf by Ferguson Simek Clark. Your application included the following items:

- executive summary in English ONLY
- application form
- supplementary questionnaire
- Information for the Water License Application
- Appendix 1 - maps and drawings
- Appendix 2 – Hazardous Materials Spill Reports
- Appendix 3 – INAC Inspection Reports
- Lagoon Remediation Report from FSC dated March 28, 2002

By copy of this letter to Ferguson Simek Clark we formally request the \$30.00 application fee in cheque form, made payable to “Receiver General for Canada” as well as the executive summary in Inuktitut. These items are required to complete the application.

This project is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Planning Commission and by the Nunavut Impact Review Board due to its municipal status.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a notice of your application is required. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take “...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings].”

Accordingly, a notice in both English and Inuktitut will be posted for a period of 30 days, with the following establishments in Pond Inlet:- Hamlet Office, QIA, HTO, Northern Store, and Co-op Store.

Upon request from the public, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application. Any person who is affected by this application or concerned with it, may submit a letter of concern, which must be submitted to the Board within the period of time shown on the public notice.
