Dear Bhabesh Roy,

Fisheries and Oceans Canada is presently reviewing Pond Inlet Water Licence Renewal Application. Before we provide comments to the board, I have some aspect I would like clarification on.

- I see on the map that you provided to the Nunavut Water Board (FIG 3 IMLE) that the road will be crossing more than one waterbody; are there culvert installed at the other crossing; if not, do you have any plans for these crossing.

Yes, Plan to install this summer as soon water licence is renewed on Salmon Creek crossing.

- Do you know if fish are present at each of those waterbodies.

Salmon creek, I do not think so. Salmon River probably yes. I do not have any kind of study available.

- In the technical summary of the environmental project it says that Salmon creek is the main potable water source for this community but in the water licence renewal application it says that Salmon River is the water source. Can you please clarify on this. If it is the creek, does it contain sufficient water in it year round to provide water to the municipality. Also, is there fish present in this creek?

It should be Salmon creek. It becomes frozen during winter. We have a water storage reservoir next to the creek . The storage reservoir is filled extracting water from the Salmon creek each summer for annual use.
