The proponent has committed to the following:

ECCC 1 - to submit a plan for management of leachate within four (4) months of when the Covid 19 travel ban is lifted and that this plan can be a condition of the new licence. We would support this approach.

ECCC 2 - to developing a general site plan with the monitoring station within four (4) months of the Covid 19 travel ban being lifted and this could be a condition of the new licence. We would support this approach. ECCC notes that the proponent did not responded to ECCC's request to provide QA/QC results.

ECCC 3 – to submit a plan detailing timelines and plans for replacement of the existing lagoon within four (4) months of the Covid 19 travel ban being lifted and have it be a condition of the new licence. We would support this approach.
