Hello Richard,

The applicant's responses address Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada's comments and we would like to offer the following points:

- Since the applicant has clarified the water source is the same as was used previously (Salmon River/Creek), CIRNAC would not be looking for a hydrology study. Any resources and efforts would be better spent on the landfill.
- Improvements to landfill management are important to protect water. The proposal for a March 2021 plan of incremental advances to better operations at solid waste facility operations is reasonable, and we encourage the applicant to start actions as soon as possible.
