

Strategic Infrastructure Fund – Preliminary Project Brief

Community: Pond Inlet Project: Water Line

Explanation

The Pond Inlet water supply is a natural lake some 4km outside of the community. Significant time and resources are spent in operating a stand alone pumphouse and 4km road to ensure access as and when required. In addition, the community uses smaller trucks requiring additional trips to the truck fill station thus resulting in inefficiencies in the delivery of water.

In addition, have the water truck fill station some 4 km outside the community limits the ability of the community fire department to respond effectively to a fire. Pond Inlet is a decentralized community and has some large structures.

The scope of the work would involve planning (to confirm the technical feasibility of the project) design and construction of the system.

The total estimated cost for this project is approximately \$5.0 Million.

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
