Good morning Philip,

To recap my conversation with Bhabesh this AM, and my understanding of your needs;

The Hamlet has a need to decant the sewage lagoon because it is near capacity. The underground pipe is as usual frozen and thus they must use a pump and hose and pump the effluent over the top of the berm and into the drainage channel located adjacent to the lagoon.

There is an urgency to this request because the lagoon is near capacity and the integrity of the berms is in question.

Given the above and assuming this is correct the hamlet must comply with the following;

1. Send notification of the intent to decant the lagoon to the water resource Officer- (me) here in Iqaluit
2. Collect and send out for analysis samples as outlined in the water license.

The second may prove to be most difficult if you do not already have the required bottles etc necessary to conduct the sampling.

If that is the case please let me know and depending on if we can get them to you today or tomorrow maybe I can send up some bottles to you in Pond so this can be done. If not then I we may have another issue that we can deal with at a later date.

Anyway, Please send me notification of your intent to decant the lagoon and we can go from there.
