RE: Acceptance Letter for Modification to the Intake of the Water Truck Filling station

Dear Mr. Roy,

The Nunavut Water Board (the NWB or the Board) received on January 27, 2020, a notice and supporting documents (Application) with respect to modifications requested under Licence No. 3BM-PON1520 (Licence) that include modification of the Intake of the Water Truck Filling station. The following documents were submitted along with the application:

- 1. Site Plan
- 2. Plan and Section
- 3. Proposed Design
- 4. Relative location of the Simoon creek and Water Lake
- 5. Notice of Modification

The NWB's review of the Application determined that the scope of changes proposed in the Application is of such that they do not constitute amendments to existing Licence. The Licensee is therefore authorized to undertake the modifications as proposed in its Application. However, the Licensee should note that if the scope of the modifications were to change following issuance of this letter, it is the responsibility of the Licensee to inform the Board and request reconsideration of this authorization.

The Licensee should note that following completion of the proposed modifications, it is required, according to Part E, Item 3 of the term and conditions in the existing Water Licence No. 3BM-PON1520, to submit as-built plans and drawings to the Board for review.

The NWB notes that under Part F, Item 1 of the Licence the Licensee shall, within ninety (90) days from issuance of the Licence, submit to the Board for review, a Solid Waste Disposal Facility Update Report (Report) including photographic record, which demonstrates the

implementation of the commitments and measures to clean-up existing facilities.

Further, the NWB notes that under Part F, Item 2 the Licensee is required to submit to the Board for approval within ninety (90) days following issuance of the Licence an updated consolidated Operations and Maintenance Manual (O&M Manual) consisting a number of documents, including a Water Supply Facility Operations and Maintenance Plan.

To date, the NWB has no record of receiving this information. Therefore, the Licensee is reminded that the Report and O&M Manual stated above still be submitted to the Board for review and approval. The O&M Manual shall include, along with the listed documents, an updated Water Supply Facility Operations and Maintenance Plan reflecting the proposed modifications.

In addition, the Licence is required under Part G, Item 2 of the existing licence to submit an Abandonment, Restoration, and Closure Plan, at least six (6) months prior to abandoning any facilities or upon submission of the final design drawings for the construction of new facilities to replace existing ones, including Water intake facilities.
