I am writing to confirm that the Municipality of Qikiqtarjuaq Water License # 3-BM-QIK 1924 Type B will be expired on September 19th, 2024.

Following the new application procedure, we submitted the project first to Nunavut Planning Commission. We received a notification from NPC, File # 150433 dated May 23,2024 that the project proposal for the amendment and renewal of the Municipality of water license application is exempt from both NPC and NIRB. Therefore, I am submitting the following document to Nunavut Water Board for consideration and recommend renewing the Water License for 5 years effective from September 20th, 2024 based on the existing condition.
